To create an over-sized planter or a long run of planters, our Multi-Section Planters are easy to install and more cost-effective than individual planters. Perfect for roof decks because the light-weight, modular design allows maintenance access.

We combine our Mariner corner with our Mariner T-leg to join lengths of wood, recycled plastic lumber or other materials to build the size you need.

For long, narrow planters, we install a frame to support the liners. For larger, deeper planters, the wooden box is a façade around self-supporting liners.

We've even built a one-sided façade for permanent installation along a 40-foot long wall—why spend money on a beautiful planter wall that no one will see?
